Die huidige NBK -lede, Tom Buckle (Vise-president), Eddie Mantle (Tesourier) en Elfie Alston (Sekretaris), het met hulle toewyding en entoesiasme, ten volle samewerking in SAGES se 28 takke bewerkstellig.

Vir hulle toewyding en professionele bestuur van hulle onderskeie funksies, my hartlike dank en waardering.

- **KANKER**

- **CANCER**

Elfie Alston's input in various areas, related to communication, as well as his contribution with the scorekeeping during the National- and regional tournaments, does not go unnoticed.

• **TOURNAMENTS**
