

Guidelines for Sages Name Badges (Revised June 2024)

1. General

Lapel badge for members (Royal blue background) and Nationals 0-4 years attended



All the badges are approximately 65mm long and 20mm high, but can be enlarged to accommodate exceptional longer names. The Sages logo is on the left-hand side of the badge. The name is in BOLD CAPITALS, aerial 18 point, and the branch name is in lower case bold aerial 14 point. A thin line borders all the badges. It has the same colour as the lettering on the badge. The badges are made of granule material 3mm thick. The fastening mechanism is magnetic.

2. Badges for recognition of Nationals Tournaments attended more than 4. In all cases the name is in BOLD CAPITALS aerial, and the branch name lower case bold aerial 14 point.

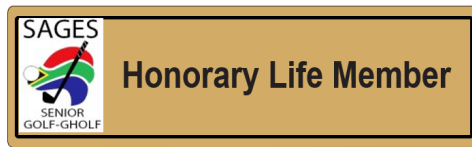

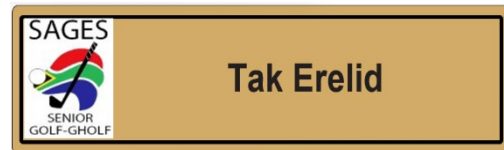
3. Badges for honorary life members

This badge has a gold background with black lettering.

Lower case bold aerial 14 point with the description of “Honorary Life Member” or “Lewenslange Erelid”



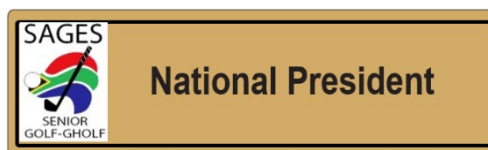

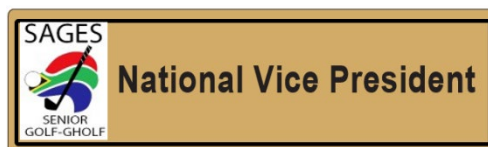
4. Badges for NMC Members.

Members who serve on the National Management Committee (NMC) wear a lapel badge with gold background and black lettering. The **lower-case bold** aerial 14 point displaying the position on the management committee ONLY

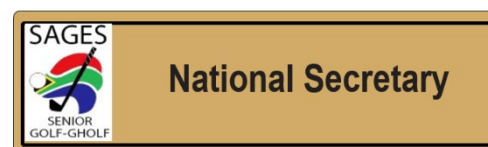
a) National President



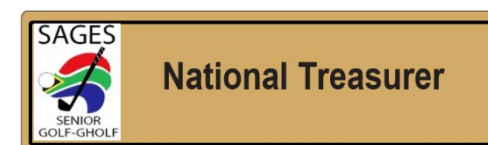
b) National Vice President

5. Badges for Branch Committee Members.

Sages who serve on the Branch Committee wear their normal sages name banner together and the position the member occupies on the Committee, aerial **lower case bold** 14 point.
