#### **Chairmans report 2026**

##### **General**

The branch has had another good year, our membership has increased from 77 at the end of last year to 94 members today. I would like to take this opportunity to welcome all our new members to SAGES and to thank all our members for your support.

Our financial position is very good and will be detailed in the financial report from Dantjie.

This year we published 10 issues of Grys wys and our Whatts – App groups for members and the Management committee group are working well.

We still have instances where members have recorded incorrect scores on the HNA system. This is not in the spirit of SAGES but we will continue to check all the scores from SAGES games submitted to the HNA system and members who have submitted an incorrect score will be contacted in order to have the score corrected at their home golf club.

We have not raised the yearly subs or the joining fee this year and the playing fee of R220 will stay the same.

##### **Clothing**

The dress code is stipulated in the constitution and all branches must adhere to this. Having said this, new members will be given some grace but are expected to comply as soon as possible. At regional and inter branch competitions the dress code will apply fully.

### **Tournaments**
